The Present

- Optimisation

- Yhc.ByteCode
 - A nice library for bytecode
- Ycr2js Javascript back end
 - Thanks to Dimitry
- Flash bytecode
- Java backend
- PDA ports, Lego Mindstorms

The Future

- Stronger libraries (like Parser)
- Better front end
 - nhc stuff is "very crusty"
 - Needs rewriting from scratch (Qhc?)
- Support for base/Cabal
- Scons a source of pain
 - Scons/make/Cabal none are pleasant
